

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14  
CITY OF BRADFORD METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COUNCIL  
MARLEY STREET, KEIGHLEY**

**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC (NO 917) ORDER**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council by reason to enable water works to be executed on or near Marley Street, Keighley has made the above named Order the effect of which is that no person shall proceed in the length of Marley Street from its junction with South Street to its junction with Heber Street.

PROVIDED THAT such prohibition shall not extend to emergency vehicles or to vehicles being used in connection with the works proposed to be carried out on the said length of road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the Order are available via Marley Street (unaffected section), Sun Street, Worth Way, South Street and vice versa.

The Order comes into operation at 08:00 hours on 29th January 2019 and remains in force until 19:00 hours on 29th January 2019 (although the closure can remain in force for up to eighteen months if necessary).
